1. Responsible Use of the Internet









We use computers to help us learn and children will be given more opportunities to use the internet as they progress through school.

As part of pupils' curriculum enhancement and the development of ICT skills, Glenfield School is providing supervised access to the Internet, including e-mail.

Our school internet access provider operates a filtering system that restricts access to inappropriate materials and will only use search engines approved by Southampton City Council.

Whilst every endeavour is made to ensure that suitable restrictions are placed on the ability of children to access inappropriate materials, the school cannot be held responsible for the nature of content of materials accessed through the Internet.

The school will not be liable under any circumstances for any damages arising from your child's use of the Internet facilities.

-  I will only use the computer when there is an adult in the room.
-  I will use my class log-on and password.
-  I will only use the computers for school work.
-  I will only send emails to people my teacher has approved.
-  All messages I send will be polite and sensible.
-  I will not give my home address, phone number or arrange to meet anyone without permission.
-  I will tell my teacher if I see anything on the Internet I do not like.
-  I understand that the school can check my computer files and the Internet sites I visit.



2. Allergies

As part of our varied and exciting curriculum during the year we sometimes give the children the opportunity to make and taste different foods. It is very important that we are advised if there are any foods your child cannot eat. It is also important that you keep us informed if anything changes.

3. Face Painting

The children will get the opportunity to have their faces painted as part of MOOL time or perhaps a school play. Or as Special Time for excellent behaviour.

4. Use of Digital/Video Images

The use of digital/video images plays an important part in learning activities. Students/Pupils and members of staff may be using digital or video cameras to record evidence of activities in lessons and out of school. These images may then be used in presentations in subsequent lessons and for assessments.

Images may also be used to celebrate success through their publication in newsletters, on the school website and occasionally in the public media. The school will comply with the Data Protection Act and request parents/carers permission before taking images of members of the school. We will also ensure that when images are published that the young people cannot be identified by the use of their names.

Every year a class photograph is taken which is available for all parents to purchase. Please confirm that you are happy for your child to be present in this photograph.

On occasions photos of small groups of children are taken, the children decorate the print and you have the opportunity to purchase the photo which includes your child.

By ticking the relevant box on the back page of this document you agree to the school taking and using digital/video images of your child. You understand that the images will only be used to support learning activities or in publicity that reasonably celebrates success and promotes the work of the school.

If you take digital or video images at, or of, school events which include images of other children, they must not be posted on, or shared with any social media accounts.

5. Local visits throughout the school year

As a part of the curriculum we may occasionally like to take your child's class on visits to areas around our school. These visits may include the Library, the Post Office, the vets or Bitterne Shopping Precinct. In order for us to be able to do this we require a general consent from you as the parent. These trips will take place during the course of the academic year.

6. School Library Loans

The children have the opportunity to loan books from our lovely new library. If books are returned damaged or are lost - the cost of replacement will be charged to parents.

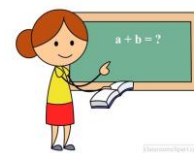
7. Home School Agreement

The home school agreement is a statutory document. By working together in close partnership we can achieve so much more for your child.

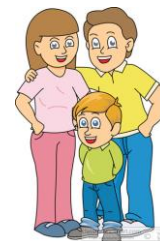
As a school we are committed to:
