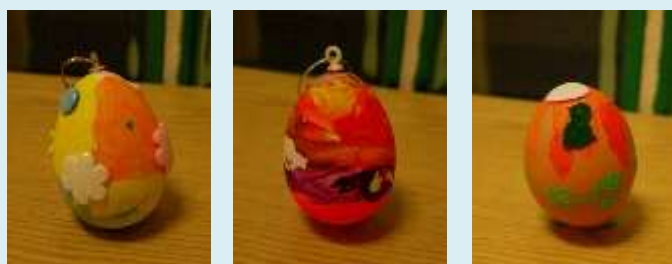


EGGSCITING COMPETITION
