

How can you make this sentence more exciting by using adjectives and conjunctions?

*The boy went down the road.*

Here are some questions you can think about:

- What sort of day was it? (early, late, sunny, Monday, morning, evening, grey, bright etc)
- Who was the boy? How old is he? What does he look like?
- How did the boy move? Quick, slow, quiet, sprinting, galloping, creeping etc.
- What was the road like? long, windy, wet, dusty.
- Where was the boy going and why? Was the boy alone?

When writing your sentences, remember capital letters and full stops and think about when you can use a conjunction instead of a full stop and when a full stop is better. If using more than one adjective, don't forget to use commas to separate them.

Here is an example:

*One sunny, bright Monday morning a young boy wearing stripy shorts and a floppy hat skipped merrily down the long, dusty road. The boy was feeling happy because he was on his way to visit the zoo and see his favourite animals such as the tall giraffes, the wide, grey elephants and the fierce lions. He couldn't wait!*
