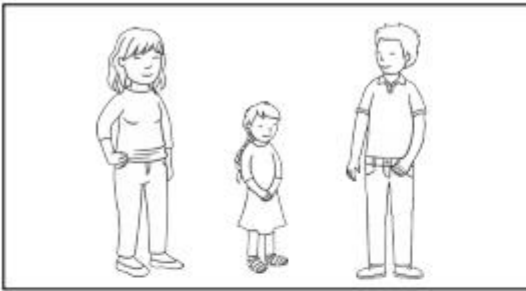

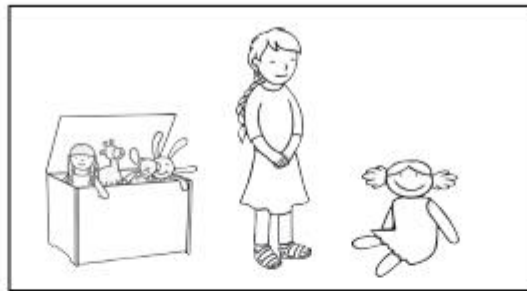

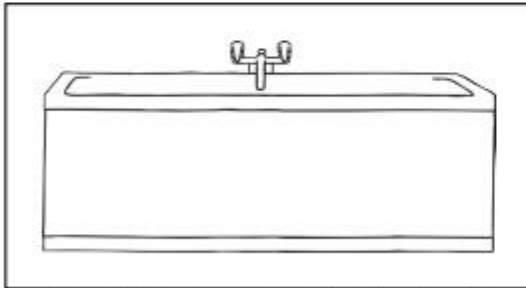
Beth has a mum and a dad.

dad is Seth.



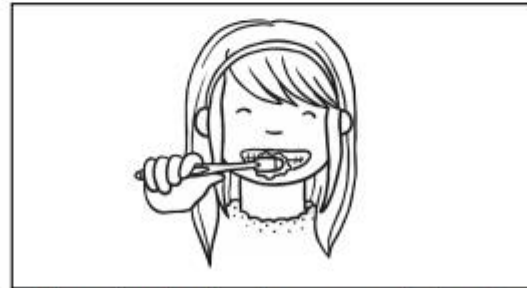
Beth is three and she has fun. She

Cath is the doll.



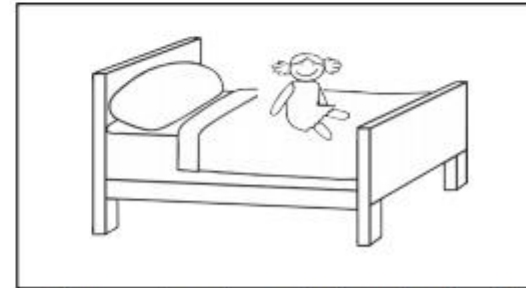
She has thick hair and it is soft.
