Communicate: When do we say thank-you?

Discuss with class times that we say thank you. Why do we say thank you? Role play scenarios of saying thank you e.g. giving a present, helping someone, giving someone a compliment etc..

Evaluate: Why is it important for Christians to say thank you at Harvest?

Discuss in circle time. Do pupils think it is important for Christians to say thank you at Harvest? Why? Why not?

Apply: What are you thankful for?

Discuss what we could say thank you for. Show images of some of the things we might say thank you for e.g. grown-ups for looking after us, friends for being kind to us, dinner staff for making our lunch, lollipop person for helping us to cross the road.

Assessment task: What are you thankful for? Record chns responses on a speech bubble. Children to draw picture to accompany if appropriate.

Contextualise: How do Christians say thank you at Harvest?

Visit a local Church or have a visit from local vicar to talk about how Christians say thank you at harvest. Look at images/PowerPoints about harvest. Share a harvest poem/prayer about saying thank you to God.

Enquire: How do we show that we are thankful?

Talk about ways that people show that they are thankful. Discuss other ways that people show that they are thankful e.g. give a gift, flowers, a card, a hug, do a kind act in return.
