To stay safe when you are searching online, we recommend that you use the child-friendly search engine:

Did you know that the camera on an iPhone or iPad works as a QR code reader?

This search engine filters out anything which is not suitable for children to see or read. **Please supervise you child when they are working online.**

Once you have found out as much as you can about the owl(s), your challenge is to use what you now know to create an information poster for your owl(s).

Remember to present your facts clearly, use images with labels, colour to make your poster eye-catching, and have a title to tell us what your poster is all about. You can even add your drawing from yesterday to make part of your poster.
