What continent is the UK part of? We are part of Europe.



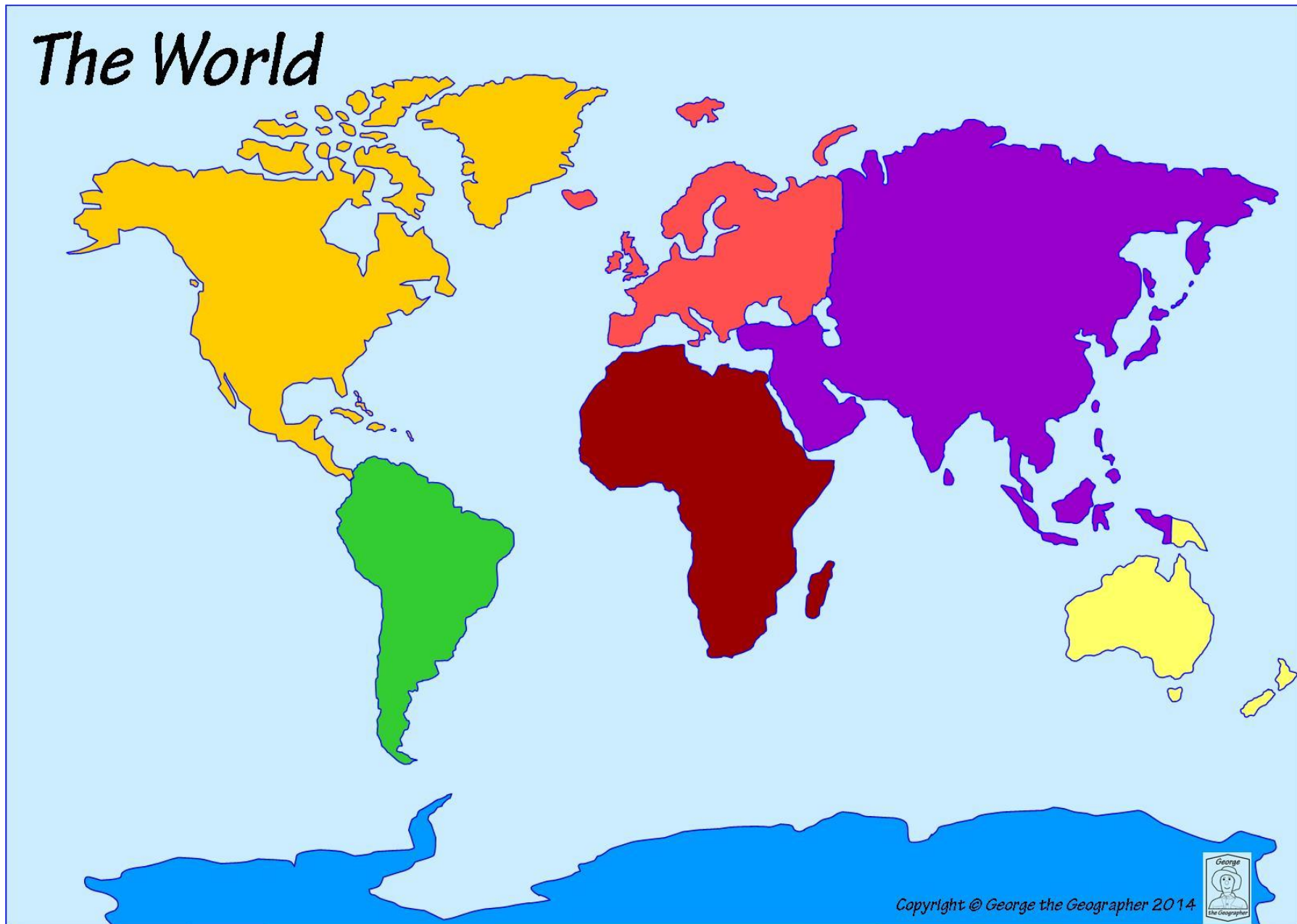
We are here – We live in the UK (United Kingdom) We live in a country called England.
