Trunk

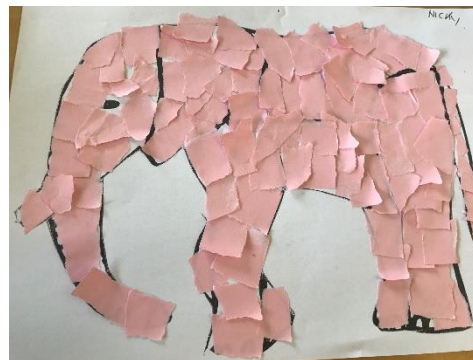
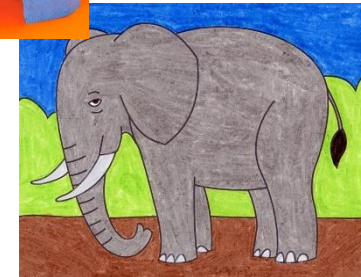
