

Autumn Sentence Dice

Cut out and stick together your two autumn dice. Roll both of the dice and write a sentence about the word and picture on one of the dice, using the punctuation or word on the other dice.

For example, if you roll the tree and and, you could create the sentence:

The **'tree'** has orange **'and'** brown leaves.



You do not have to print the dice. Number each picture and punctuation on each dice from 1-6. I have done this on the first one but you can change the number if you like. Then use a normal dice and use the picture that is next to that number on the dice. You can roll a different number for each dice or use the same number. If you do not have a dice, use cards/number cards (1-6), shuffle the numbers, turn the cards upside down and turn two over to give you the numbers.

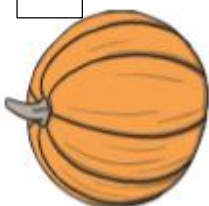
