This week is our 'final outcome' task for our non-fiction fact file about the life-cycle of a frog. This task is an opportunity for your child to **INDEPENDENTLY** apply what they have learned over the previous 2 weeks, both in terms of information and using their phonics to write simple words. 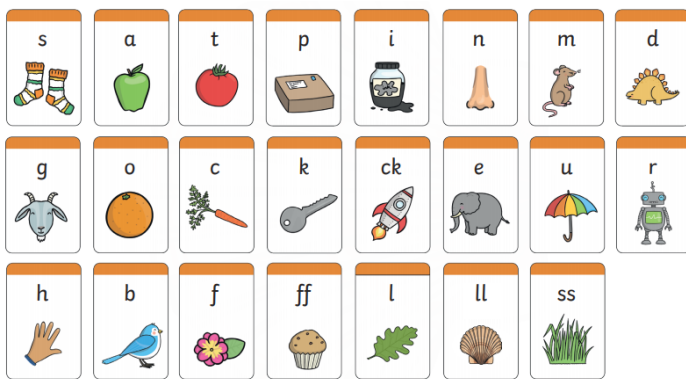
