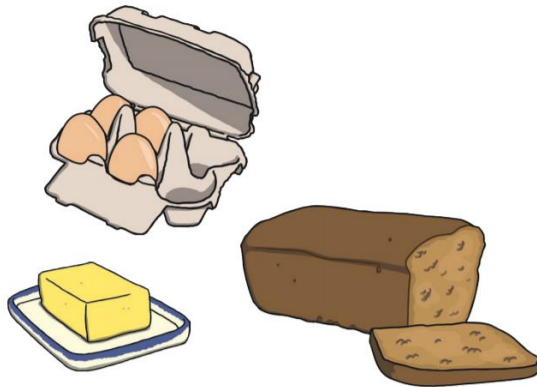
Tuesday and Wednesday

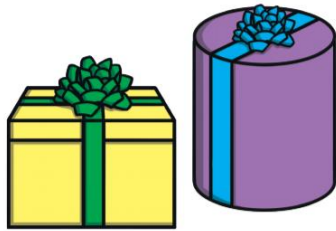
