Priority 1 😊 The aim of the learning this week is counting in 2s not money, we use money to support their learning of counting in 2s, using 2ps.

Practical maths These do not all have to be played today and they are used through the week to support counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. So although they are under priority 1 please do not feel you have to do them all, pick and choose from the ideas as it suits you. (The resources, purses/coins etc. are at the end of this document.)

Find/collect objects from around your house (Lego bricks, socks, toy cars, dolls, teddies, gloves, anything you can count.)

When counting objects today, you can only count in 2s. So each time you count you need to touch 2 of the objects, or pick up 2 of the objects.

- 1) Using the cards below, or ones you have made, shuffle the cards, and place them numbers down.
Turn over the top card and count out in 2s the correct number from your counting objects.
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Repeat until you have done all the numbers.
- 2) Ask your adult to count in 2s, spot their mistakes and show them how to count in 2s.
- 3) Using 2p coins count, in 2s how much is in each purse. (Coin and purse cut outs below, or draw purses and draw 2p coins on them.)
- 4) Using dolls or action figures or toys with 2 legs, 2 arms, etc., count how many legs/arms your toys have.
Example- 3 dolls, 2,4,6 legs altogether.

The three pig houses are located at the bottom of the page. From left to right: a straw house, a wooden house, and a brick house with a red door and a chimney.

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
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Autumn Missing Numbers

Counting in 2s



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
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Priority 2 (Have a go if you feel confident and are able to.)

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


Extra ideas

The practical maths ideas this week can be used during others parts of the day too and could get your child/children helping with the chores! *Tidying away toys, pick up 2 toys each time, counting in 2s.

*Putting washing in the machine, put two items in at the same time and count in 2s.

*Walking around the house, each step count in 2s,. example: which route round the house gets to the highest number when counting in 2s? If you count in 2s up to 16 from the kitchen where do you end up?

*Start counting from a different number other than 0,2. Example: start counting in 2s from 6 and stop at 24.
