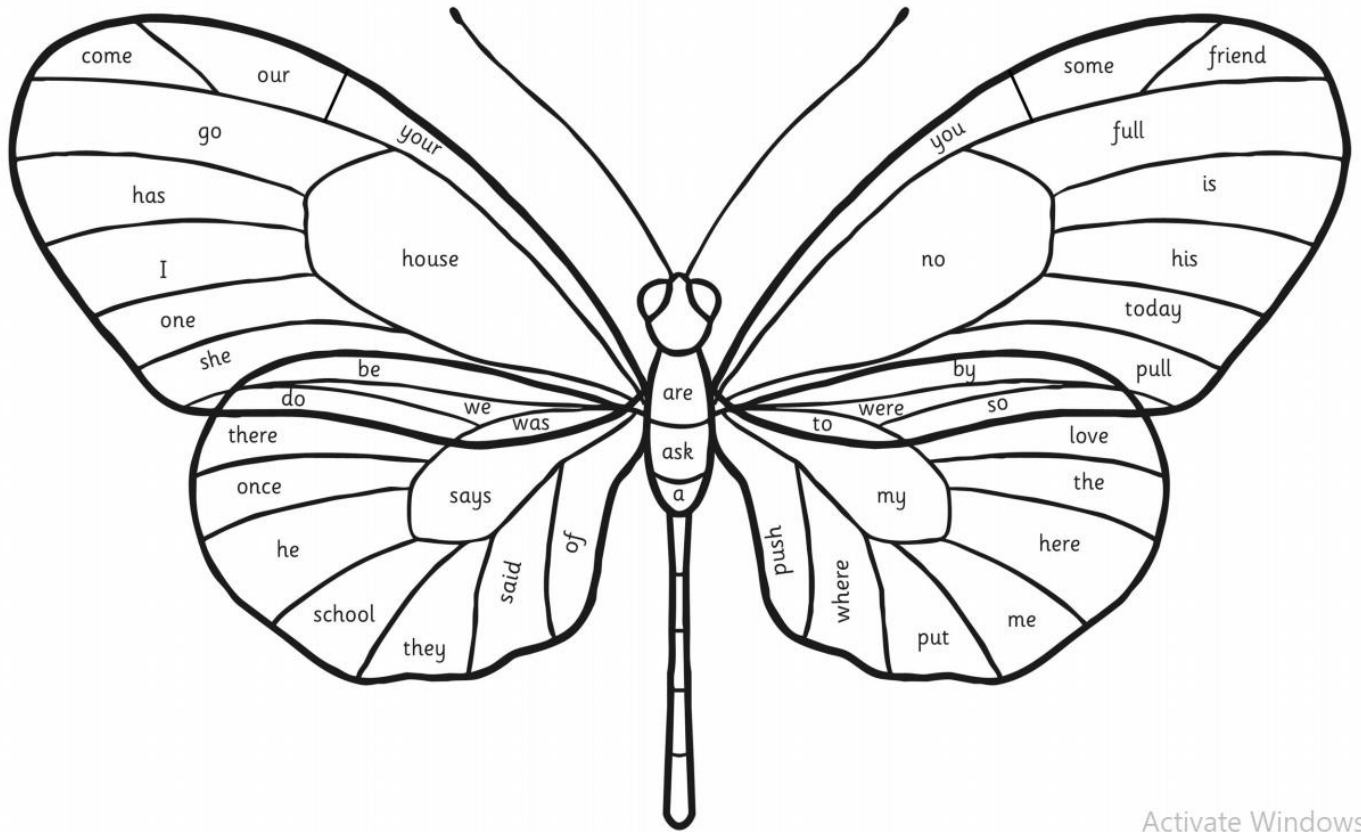

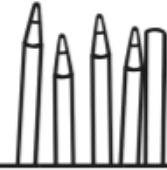

There are different ways to spell the 'ee' sound.

























