People who help us.

<p>Literacy We will read the hungry caterpillar and learn about which foods are healthy. We will write captions and labels for the foods he ate. We will also look at recipe books and learn how to follow a recipe to make a sandwich. We will use non-fiction books to learn facts about people who help us.</p>	<p>Numeracy This half term the children will continue to learn simple addition and subtraction up to 5. We are also looking at pattern in our environment and also making a repeating pattern ourselves.</p>
<p>Phonics Children will continue to learn their phase 3 digraphs and even some trigraphs. We will be continuing to recap and introduced more tricky words to read and spell. Children will be encouraged to read using the phonemes they know during the school day and to use their phonics to write simple sentences.</p>	<p>Music Children will continue having music sessions with Miss Cook. For this term children will learn, to use their voice to express different moods and explore environmental sound makers in the classroom and outside. Children will also learn to use percussion instruments and body percussion to play a steady beat</p>
<p>Physical Development We will be using our PE Hub scheme to develop children's fundamental movement skills. This term we are working on dance. We will use our bikes on the big playground and climb on the apparatus to develop our gross motor skills.</p>	<p>PSHE: We will learn how to keep healthy and fit. We will think about healthy food, cleaning our teeth, getting a good night sleep and limiting screen time. We will continue to encourage children to manage their feelings and behaviours appropriately. As children become more independent, we will encourage them to sort disputes and disagreements by talking through issues with their friends.</p>
<p>Understanding the World We are looking at the jobs people do. We have a visit from a fire fighter planned and are finding out about other people who help us. We will focus on dentists and how to keep our teeth clean. We continue to visit our woodland every Friday and notice how it is changing through the year.</p>	<p>Exploring Media and materials Art We will be learning how to print and investigating our own printing techniques, looking at different everyday items that use print: Clothing, newspapers, cards, wallpaper etc. We will print and press symmetrical butterflies.</p>
