Year 2 enjoyed a great road trip around Southampton, the incredible Walls which once encased the city and the Bargate. They have used their knowledge gained in school and combined it with their DT skills to make their very own model of the Bargate. They used various joining techniques including slits, slots and flanges. Year 1 and 2 children had the opportunity to see some of these amazing models in celebration assembly on Monday.

The children in Year 1 are enjoying their weekly 'Forest Schools' session in our fantastic grounds. Children are taking part in many activities including partner work where one child is blindfolded and their partner takes them to a tree - they then use all their senses to examine it. The child is then taken safely back to a central point where their blind fold is removed and they must then re-locate their tree. Children had great fun and it was so beneficial for their wellbeing to be immersed in the wonderful natural surroundings.

Year R are settling in well and getting to know each other along with Glenfield's rules and routines. We are so impressed with how engaged they are in phonics sessions and have already learnt the following sounds: s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g. It is really important that the children pronounce these accurately. # School Lunches at Glenfield

We want to thank parents and carers for your fantastic response by ordering your child's lunches on the new SchoolGrid system. We are, however still seeing a number of children each day without a lunch box in school and no lunch pre-ordered.

This week we've had **74** meals not pre-ordered. Moving forward after half-term we will no longer be checking every child has a meal pre-ordered each morning. If a lunch is not pre-ordered for your child, we will presume they have brought a lunch from home. To avoid food wastage, if your child is absent from school due to illness and you have pre-ordered a lunch on SchoolGrid, could you please cancel the meal by 8.45am.
