
### From the Governors:

We met as a governing body just before the half term for our early Spring meeting. We received a presentation from Louise Newman, Hamwic Governance Lead, on their review of governance arrangements and the exciting new pilot that is currently running. It is hoped we will move over to this more streamlined and targeted format for governance from September 2023. We also heard from Glenfield's Deputy Head Teacher, Ros Stamper on the school's pupil premium strategy in the school. Pupil premium is funding provided to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in school. We learned about how the funding has been used to support language, reading development and phonics support, as well as extracurricular and enrichment provision, ensuring all pupils get excellent opportunities at Glenfield. We had our usual headteachers update and reviewed the school's development plan. We were pleased to hear that the school continues to go from strength to strength!
