Every morning, I must put my bookbag in the box and coat on my peg.



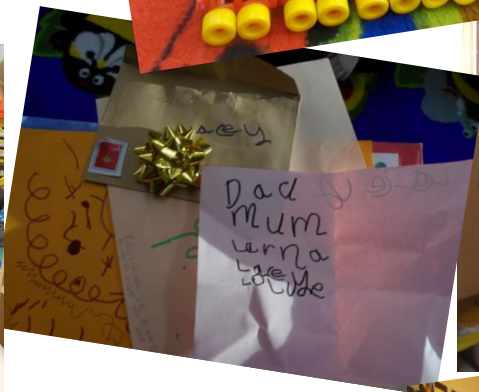
My grownups will choose what I will eat for lunch via the School Grid website or will send me in with a packed lunch.

I will also do reading, writing and counting.

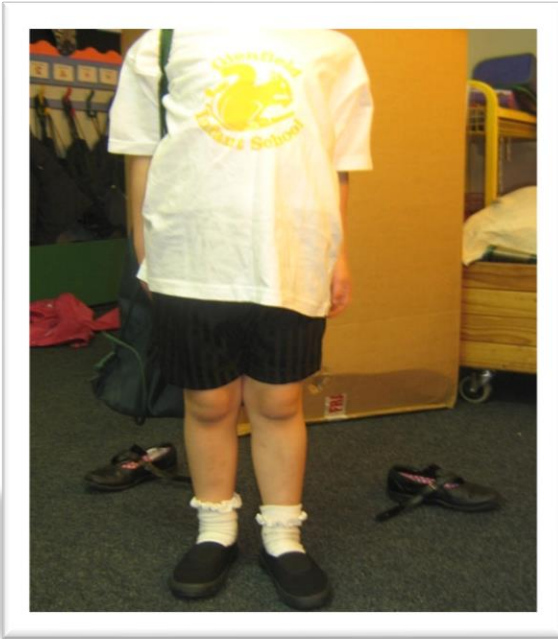
