This week (11th - 15th)

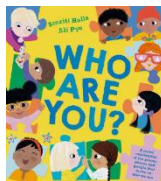
We have read 'The Gingerbread Man' story and ... made our very own gingerbread people! We had so much fun mixing up the ingredients, cutting them out and decorating them.

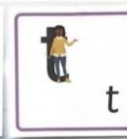


- If you're interested in becoming a part of Friends of Glenfield (FOG), please speak to Mrs Hanley, Hedgehogs teaching assistant.
