



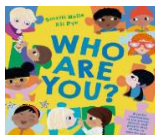

***Don't forget to please keep practising putting on shoes, socks, and coats if we can't do so.***



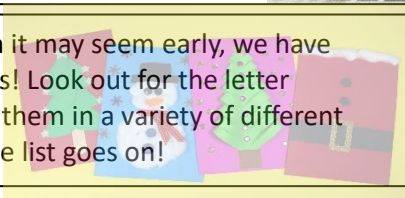
Next week (25<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup>)
